You can even use your benefits online at Glasses.com, ContactsDirect.com, LensCrafters.com, TargetOptical.com, Ray-Ban.com and Oakley.com. Good vision is important. That's why we stay focused on eye care.

How Your Benefits Work

- 1. Once your vision coverage is in effect, you can visit or call a participating provider. To find a vision provider, visit www.BlueChoiceSC.com/FindCare.
- 2. Identify yourself as a member by presenting your BlueChoice® member ID card or EyeMed vision ID card, which you should receive via mail.
- 3. Get services or materials and pay the applicable copay and any other out-of-pocket costs to the provider.
- 4. The provider files the claim for you.

Pediatric Vision Care*

For dependent children ages 18 and under, this includes:

- A \$25 copayment for one routine eye exam every benefit year.
- Up to \$40 for one standard contact lens fitting or 10 percent off the provider's nonstandard contact lens fitting fee per benefit year.
- A \$50 copayment, then 100 percent coverage for provided designated frames, once every benefit year.
- A 40 percent discount off the purchase of additional, complete pairs of eyeglasses, and a 15 percent discount on conventional contact lenses once the funded benefit has been used.

Please note for pediatric vision, members must visit a provider in the EyeMed network to receive this benefit. Costs incurred from these services count toward maximum out-of-pocket (MOOP) expenses. These benefits are essential.**



Adult Vision Care

For adults (ages 19 and over), this includes:

- A \$0 copayment for one routine eye exam every benefit year.
- Up to \$40 for one standard contact lens fitting or 10 percent off the provider's nonstandard contact lens fitting fee per benefit year.
- A \$120 material allowance with \$0 copayment every two benefit years for glasses or contacts, with no limits on frame or lens selection.
- A 40 percent discount off an additional, complete pair of eyeglasses and a 15 percent discount on conventional contact lenses once the funded benefit has been used.

Please note that members must visit a provider in the EyeMed network to receive this benefit. Costs incurred from these services do not count toward MOOP expenses. These benefits are nonessential.**
