

## QUANTITY MANAGEMENT UPDATES

### September 2020

We have recently identified overprescribing of higher-than-appropriate quantities of various topical drugs used to treat fungal foot infections. These topical creams have been prescribed for dissolving in water as “foot soaks.” However, there is no clinical data to support the effectiveness of this type of treatment. As a result, we will institute new quantity limits on the products listed below, effective Sept. 1, 2020. Impacted members will receive a letter informing them of the new quantity limits.

Drug	New Quantity Limit
GENTAMICIN SOL 0.3% OP	15 ml every 30 days
CLINDAMYCIN SOL 1%	2 ml per day
ERYTHROMYCIN SOL 2%	4 ml per day
MUPIROCIN OIN 2%	44 gm every 30 days
ECONAZOLE CRE 1%	2.84 gm per day
KETOCONAZOLE CRE 2%	2 gm per day

### October 1, 2019

Effective **October 1, 2019**, the drugs below will have new quantity limits. We will send letters informing impacted members of the changes around Aug. 1.

Drug	New Quantity Limit
Calcipotriene	120 g/month
Calcipotriene Solution	120 mL/month
Combination Products: Enstilar Aerosol, Taclonex Suspension, Calcipotriene-Betamethasone	120 g/month
Dovonex Cream, Sorilux Aerosol, Calcipotriene Ointment/Cream	120 g/month
Vectical (Calcitriol) 3mcg/gm Ointment	200 g/month

Effective **May 1, 2019**, these drugs will have quantity limits:

- Daurismo
- Lorbrena
- Talzenna
- Vitrakvi
- Xospata

The drugs in the left-hand column will have quantity limits effective **April 1, 2019**.

hydrocortisone cream, lotion and ointment	120 units/month

The drug in the left-hand column will have a quantity limit effective **January 1, 2019**. For members who have active prescriptions for this drug, we are **grandfathering them through March 1, 2019**.
